

## SAC Spectator Policies

The SAC and Lawton Community Schools will follow all MHSAA directives and guidelines. If the MHSAA changes or clarifies spectator guidelines, the SAC will make those adjustments.

The current State of Michigan and MHSAA orders limit the number of people attending an athletic contest to two invited guests per participant. If the total number allowed in exceeds 100, that is considered "permitted excess".

All invited spectators must have a school issued pass. They will also be charged a \$5 entry fee. **All entry fees must be exact change.** There is no entry for anyone who does not have the school issued pass. All spectators must wear masks at all times while at the athletic contest. This includes going to the concession stand or rest room. Social distancing while watching the contest is strongly recommended.

While this will allow parents a chance to watch the contests, it does, in many cases, exclude grandparents and students. We ask that you cooperate with the guidelines set forth as we navigate this unusual season.

The athletic directors of the SAC and the administration at Lawton Community Schools view the opportunity for our fall athletes to compete as a real privilege. We strongly implore all spectators to adhere to the policies in place which allow our young people to compete this fall.

### SAC Game Entry Protocol

1. Each participating athlete will receive 2 school issued tickets at least 1 day before the contest. Tickets will NOT be replaced.
2. The spectators will present the Lawton issued ticket to the ticket booth whether it is home or an away game.
3. Those with a school issued ticket will pay the \$5 entry fee in exact change.

### Frequently Asked Questions

**Q: Will senior passes, SAC passes, district passes, etc still be honored?**

**A:** Yes, if you are in possession of a pass you will still not be charged for entry.

**Q: If I have a senior pass, SAC pass or district pass do I still need a school issued ticket?**

**A:** Yes, Only spectators with a school issued ticket will be eligible for entry.

**Q: Will I have to wear a mask as a spectator?**

**A:** Yes, ALL spectators must wear a mask while attending a contest at all times. Individuals without a mask will be asked to leave.

**Q: What if my student loses their student issued tickets?**

**A:** Student issued tickets will not be replaced. It is the responsibility of the student to disseminate the tickets appropriately.

**Q: Who can use the student issued ticket?**

**A:** The student issued ticket can be used by any family member or friend of the student. Student issued tickets CAN NOT be sold. Students found to have sold their student issued tickets will no longer be eligible to receive future tickets.

**Q: Does an infant need a student issued ticket to enter the contest?**

**A:** ALL individuals regardless of age will need a student issued ticket to enter the contest.

**Q: What if I do not have exact change?**

**A:** Change will not be provided. Anything received over \$10 will be considered a donation.

**Q: Will a spectator be able to leave a contest and return?**

**A:** No, Re-entry will not be allowed.

**Q: Will contests be streamed on the internet?**

**A:** Yes, The district is working on live streaming home athletic contests. More details to follow.

**Q: Can spectators make a tunnel for football players entering or leaving the field?**

**A:** No spectator tunnels will be allowed this fall.

**Q: Will spectators be able to speak/meet with athletes upon completion of the contest?**

**A:** Spectators will be required to leave the facility upon completion of the contest. There will be no congregating by exits allowed. If you are your athlete's ride, please wait in your car.
