

## Did you know...?

**Since the onset of COVID 19 in the Spring of 2020** we here in food service have been very busy over the Summer implementing many new personal safety procedures, as well as, additional cleaning and sanitizing procedures to assure you that your child not only gets a nutritious meal but is in a Safe and Sanitized meal environment.

We will continue to serve breakfast every morning. The way we serve and when and where we serve may depend on the day and the number of students in attendance. We will still have a variety of options available for your child to choose from including hot breakfast sandwiches, pancakes, cereal, and even pizza for those who like lunch for breakfast. All choices of Breakfast will be available for ONLY \$2.50 a day for full pay students, 30 cents for those who qualify for reduced. Joining your child for breakfast is affordable too, only \$3.00 for adults.

Did you know...?

Along with the items listed on the lunch menu, there are always alternative choices available for students to choose from. The choices on any given day may include ham and cheese sandwiches, turkey subs or a chef salad!! Good ole' PBJ is always available as an option as well! With COVID 19 being our new normal look for us to be serving your child safe and nutritious meals in many new ways this fall. We may be serving in the classroom or even remotely, but rest assured your child will always receive a nutritious lunch full of special fruits, vegetables, and extra goodies.

Did you know...?

Lunch prices at the Elementary are still only \$2.85 per day. Secondary school lunch price is \$3.25 per day. Adult lunches are only \$4.50. Your child may be eligible to receive their lunch (AND breakfast) at no charge or at a reduced price of 40 cents. All lunches include a variety of vegetables, fruits, grains, and milk. Applications for free and reduced meals are available now in the office, or through our food service dept. It will be available after July 1<sup>st</sup> online! To load money onto your student's lunch account, you may either stop by the food service department in any of our buildings, or send payment in with your child in an envelope with your child's **first and last** name on it. (Their teacher's name on the envelope is also helpful.) If you have more than one child attending school in Lawton, it is only necessary to write one check. Let us know how much goes to each child and we'll deposit it accordingly.

**We also have an online deposit system. Contact us for your user name and password to access your child's account!**

It is in everyone's best interest to, if at all possible, pay for lunches with a credit card online or with a check. Checks are much safer and easier to track down if lost. Sending cash is at your own risk.

Who doesn't love free money!! You will receive a 5% bonus when you deposit \$25.00 or more into your child's lunch account! This option is available to student accounts that have a \$0 or above balance.
