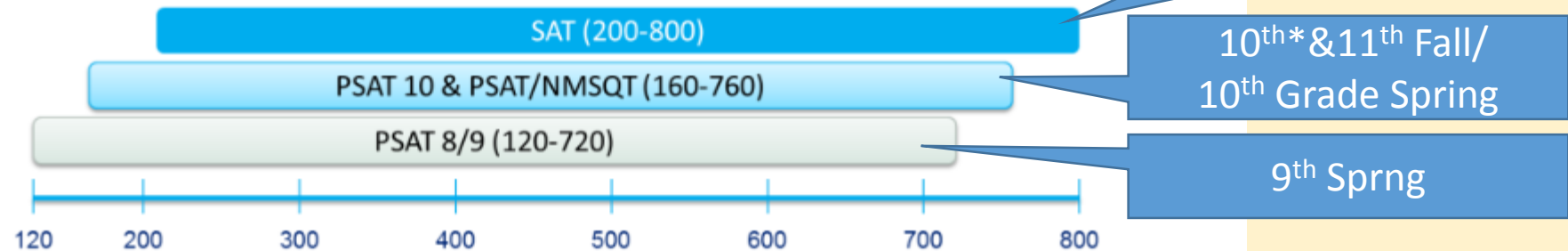

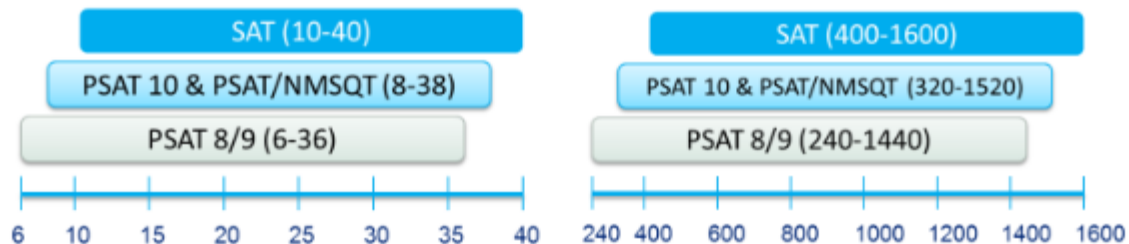
# PSAT Levels and Scoring

## Score Reporting on the SAT Suite of Assessments

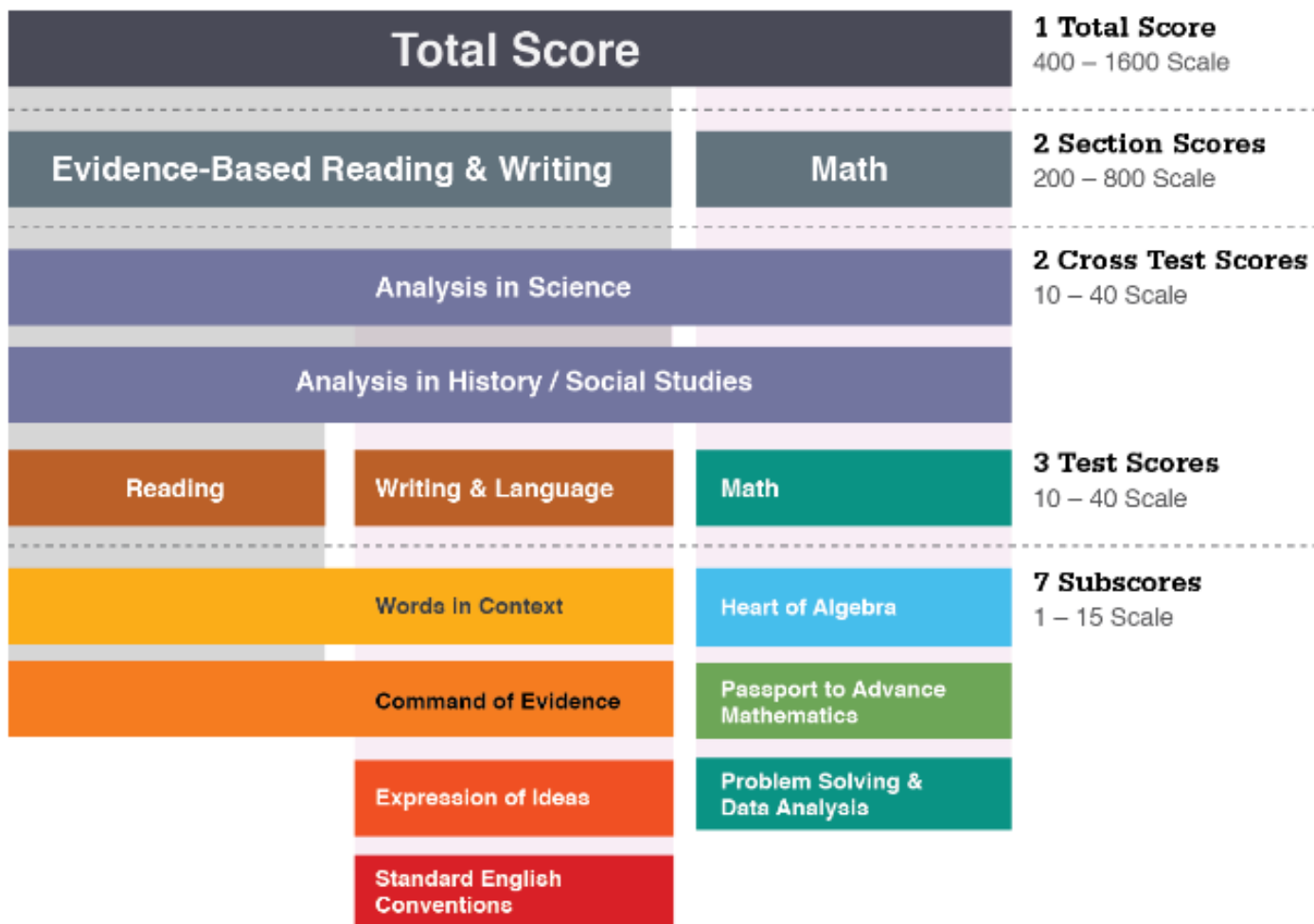
- + Section Scores will be placed on a vertical scale.



- + This same concept will hold true for the **Test and Cross-Test Scores** as well as **Total Score**.



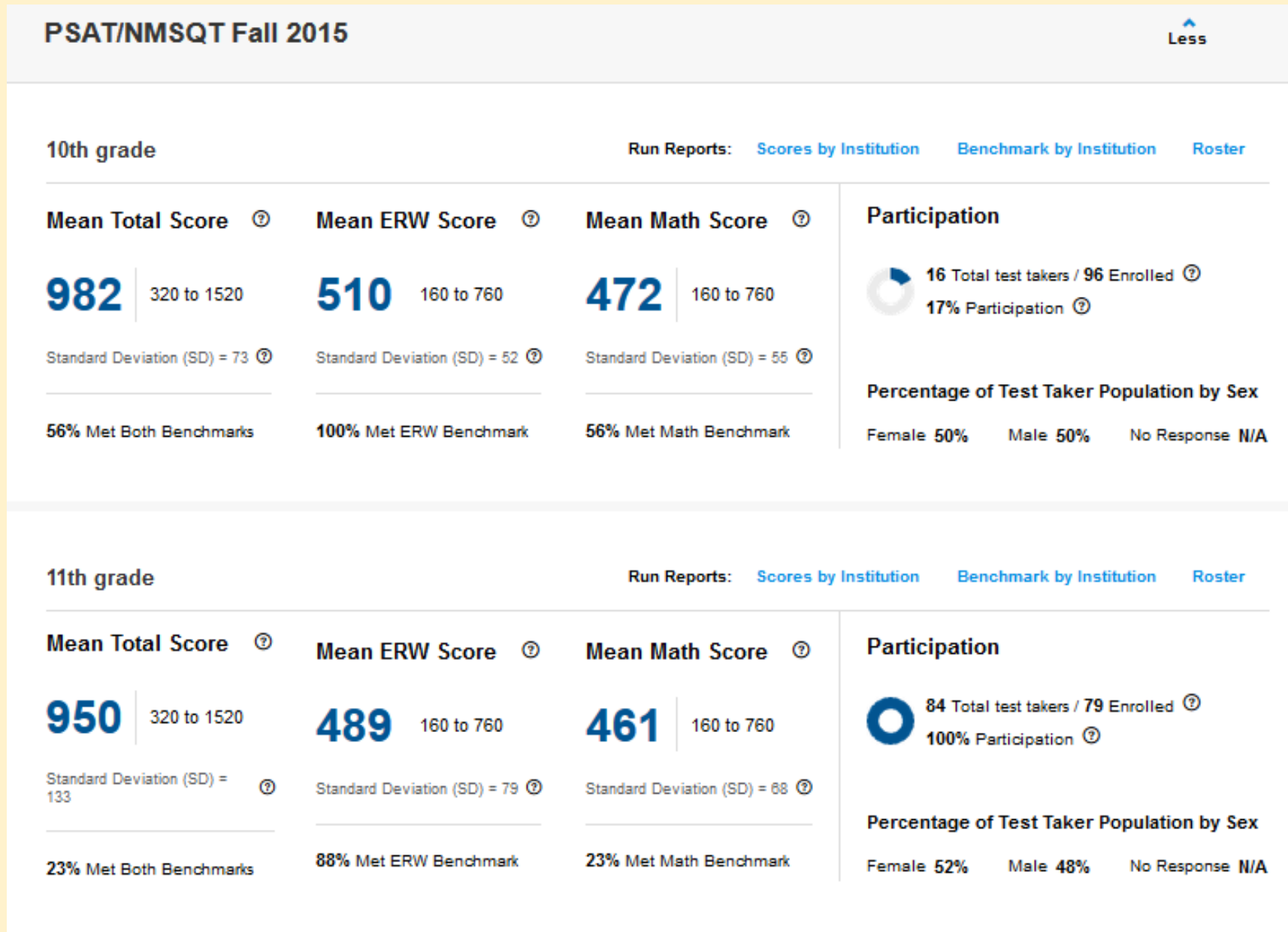

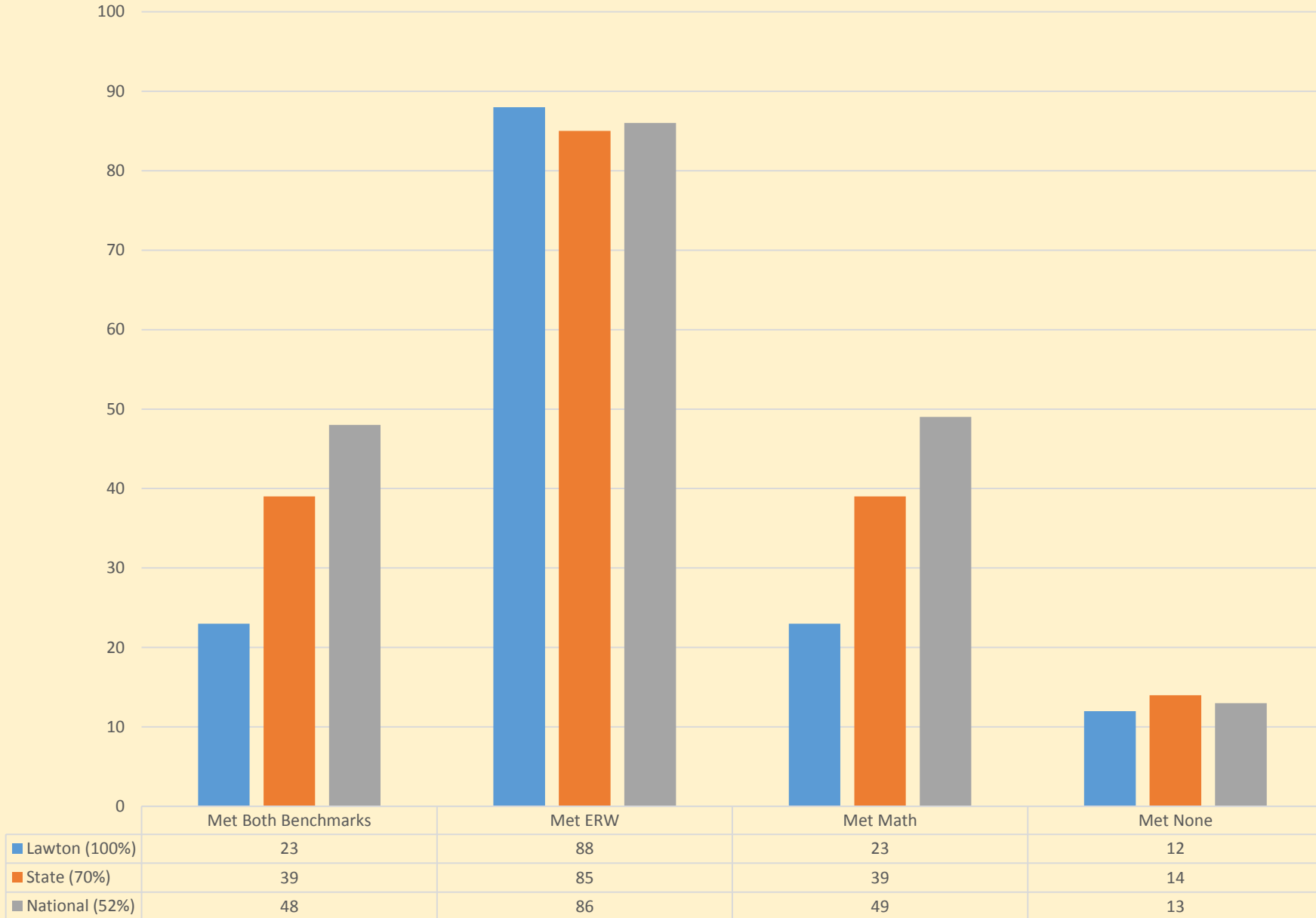

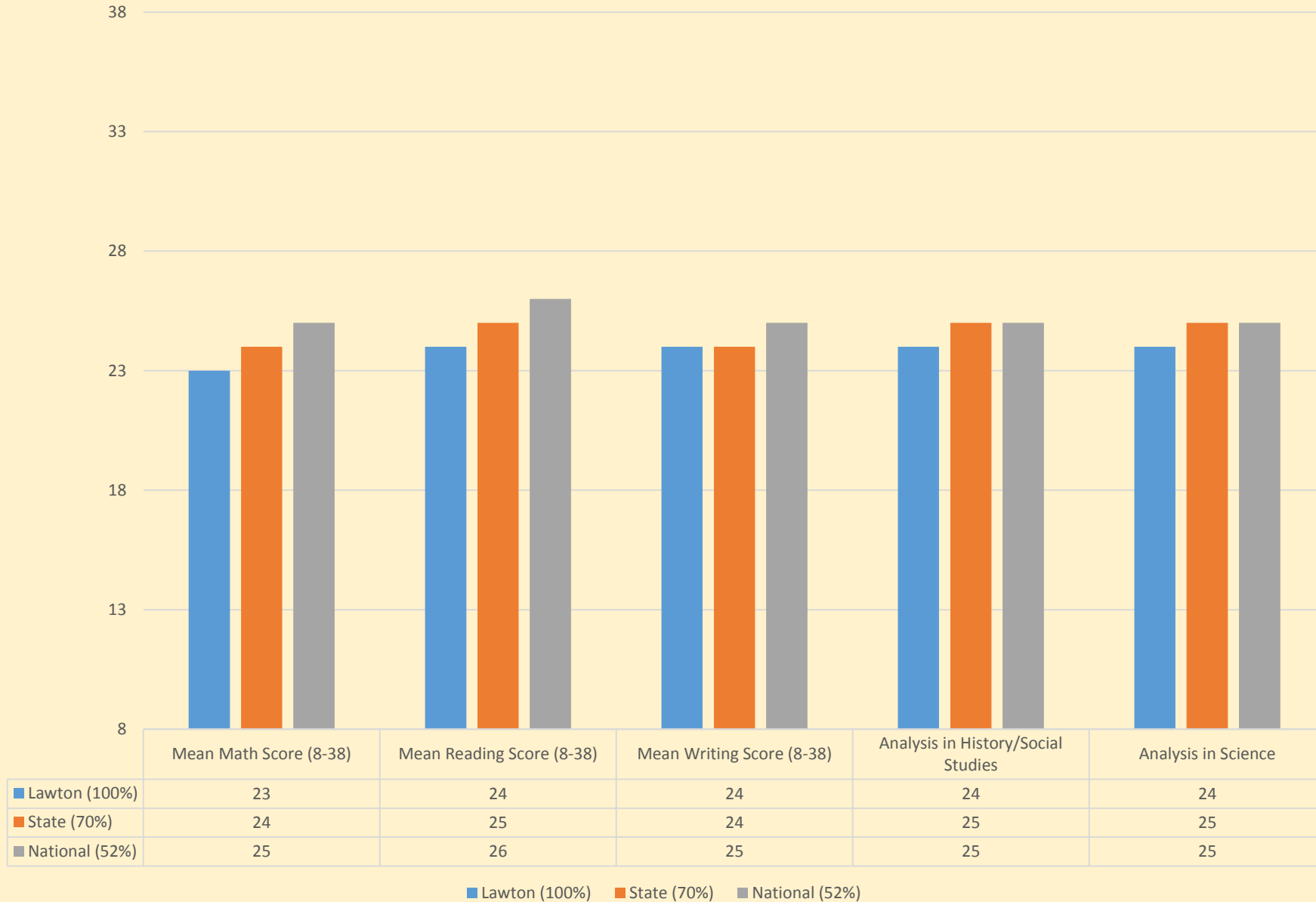

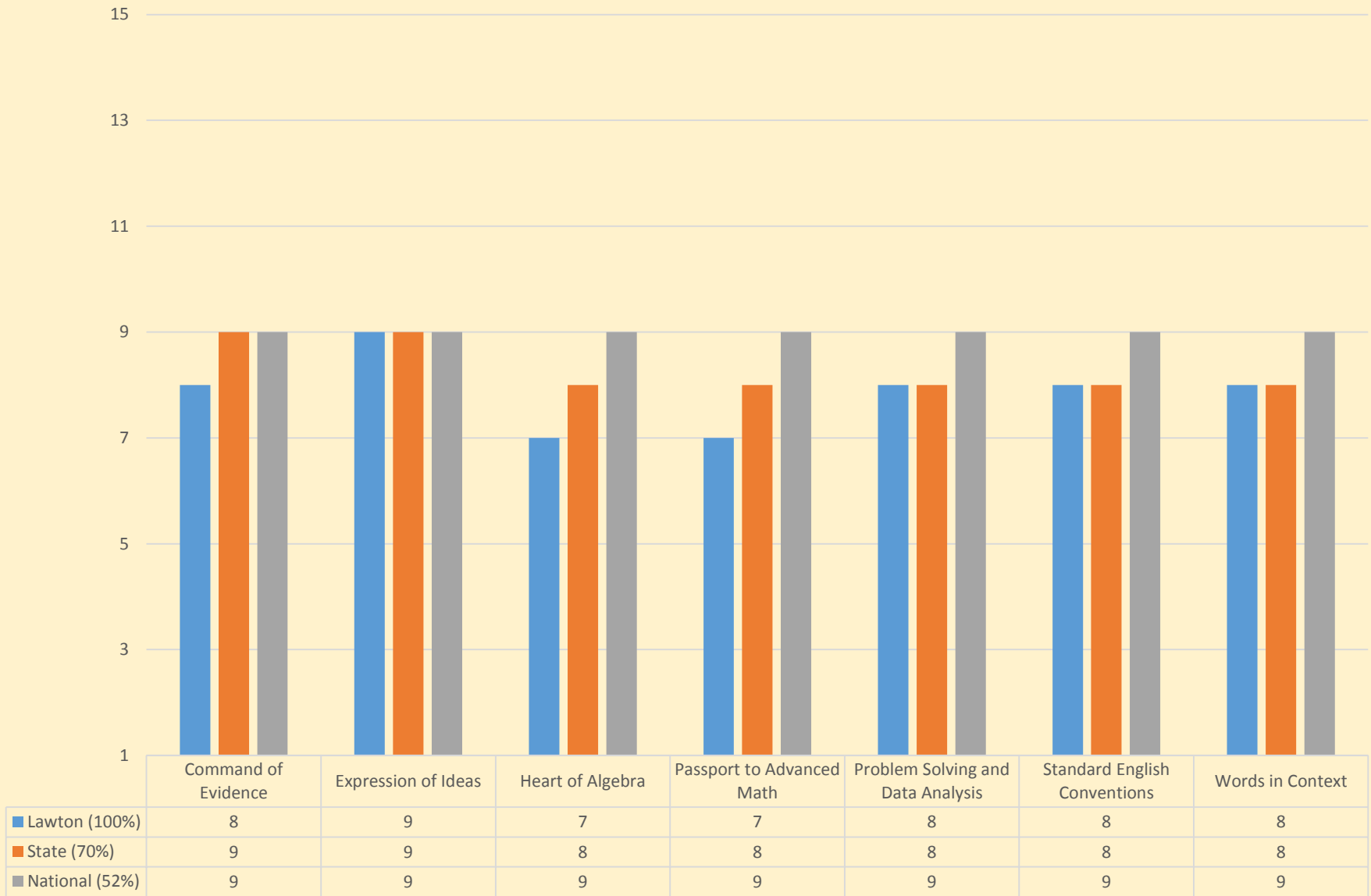
