DEMONSTRATES GOOD ATTENDANCE...

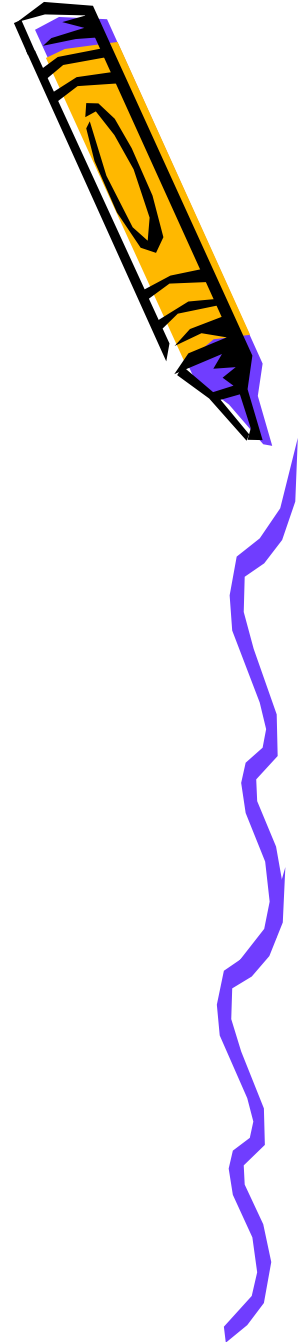


- Be here on time ready to work!

DEMONSTRATES APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR...

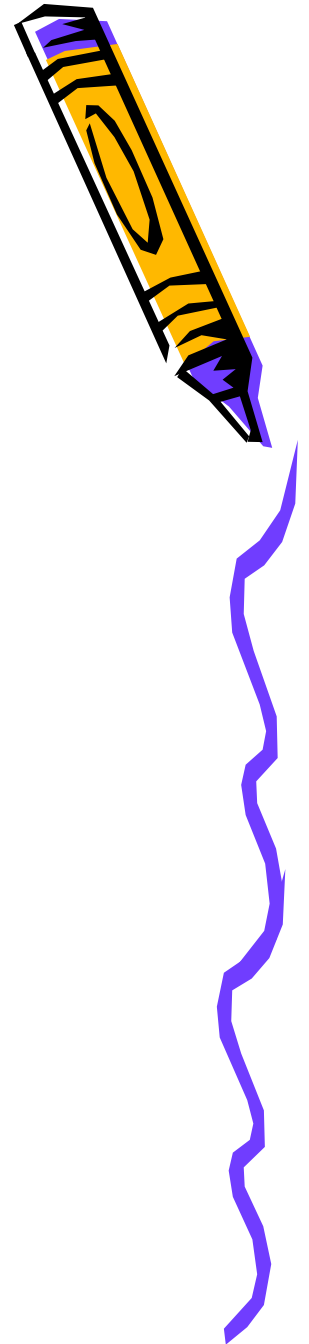
- Works for the Common Good

- Operates at Level D or C



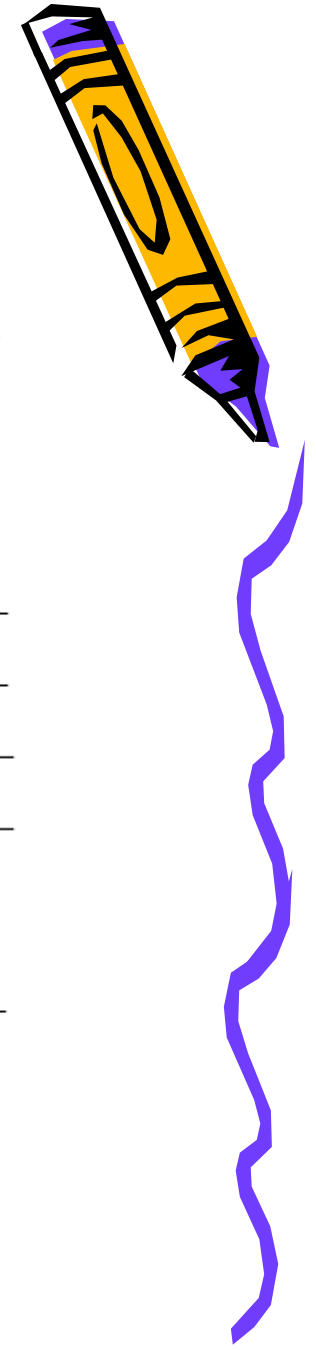
Levels Break Down D-A

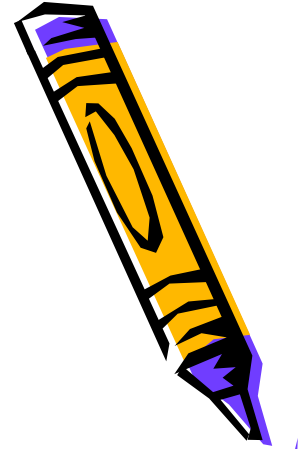
DEMONSTRATES RESPECT...

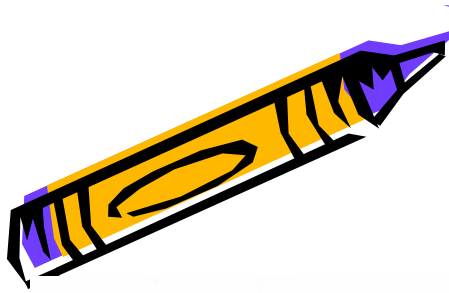
- Lives HCRR

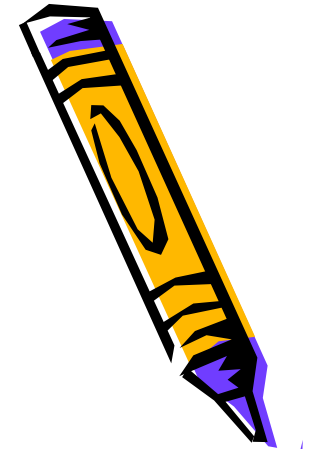


HOMEWORK IS ON TIME IF:

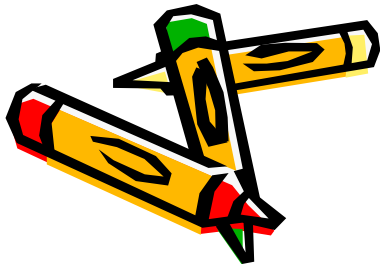
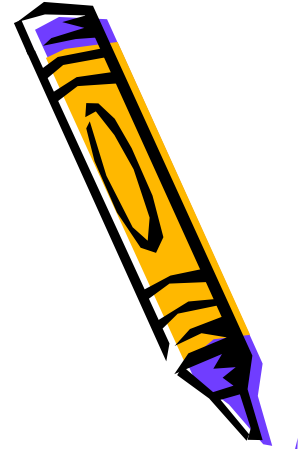

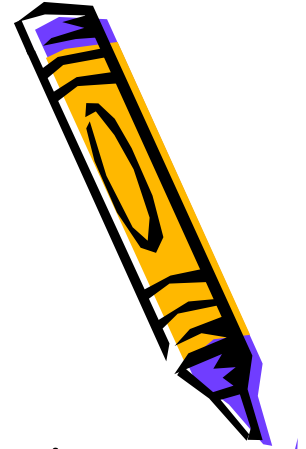
PRODUCES PASSING SCORES...(70% OR HIGHER)

- Does extra credit in all classes



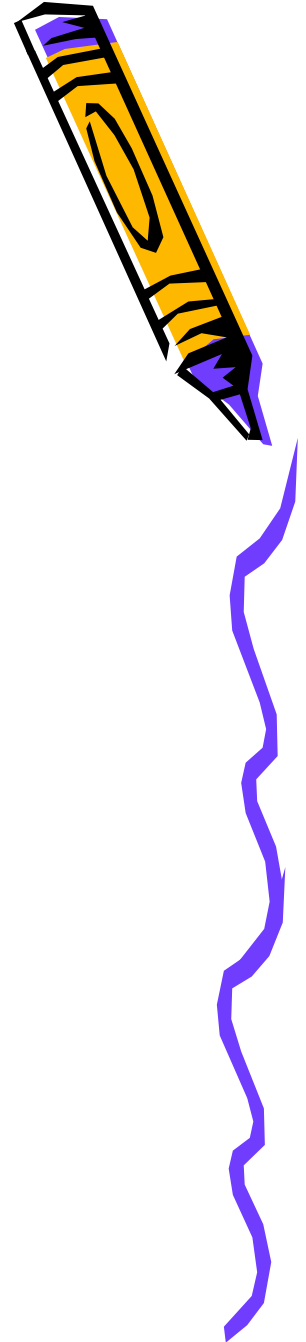
ACCELERATED READER...

- Achieves an average book level goal at 85% or higher



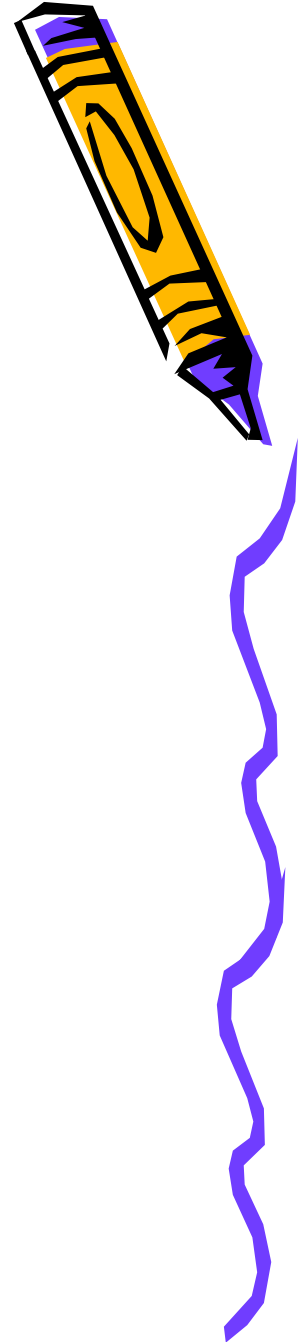

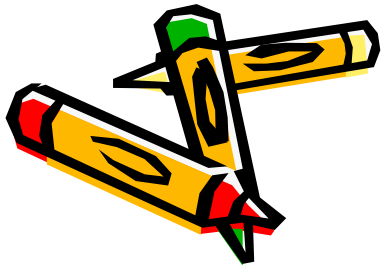
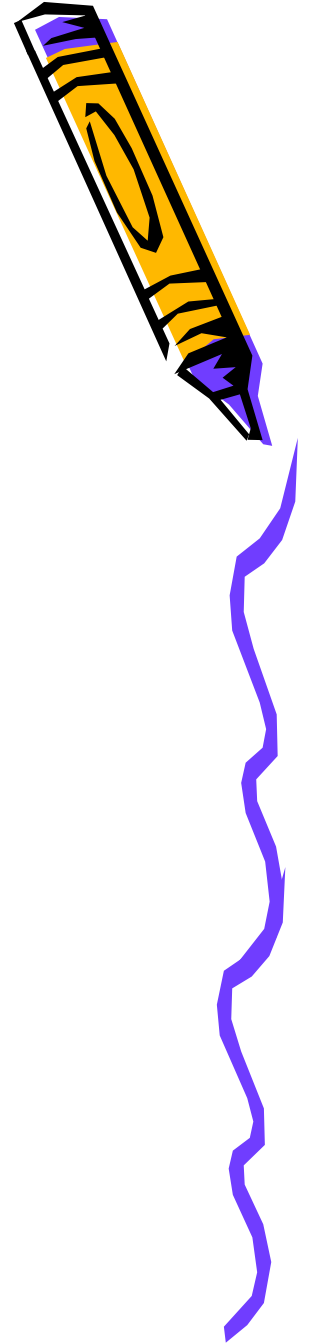
FUN FRIDAY...

- Students at Level A or B will have study hall or will be retaught appropriate behaviors/procedures



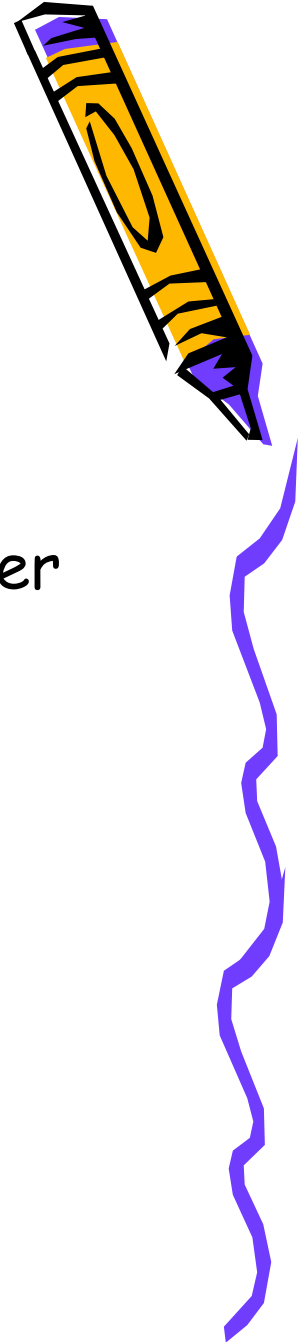

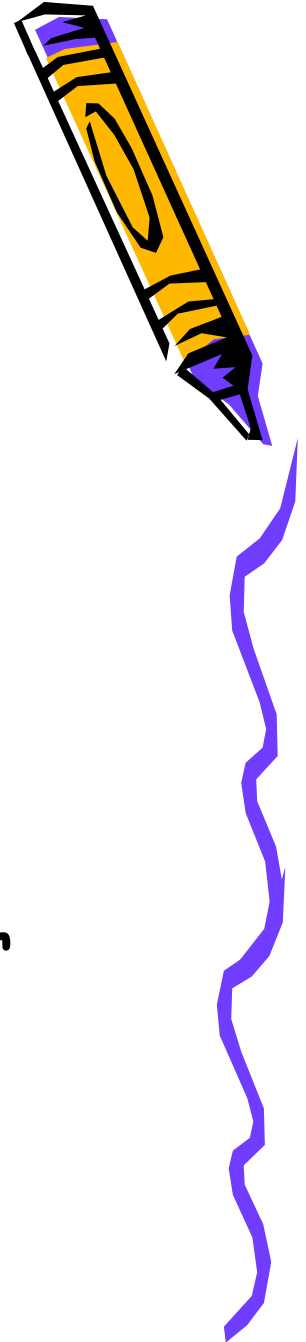

- Sign up for conferences with your child's homeroom teacher.



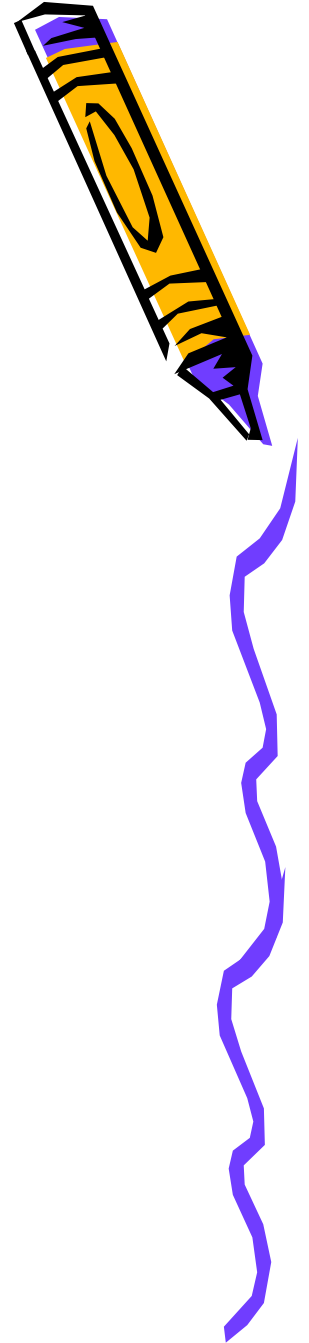

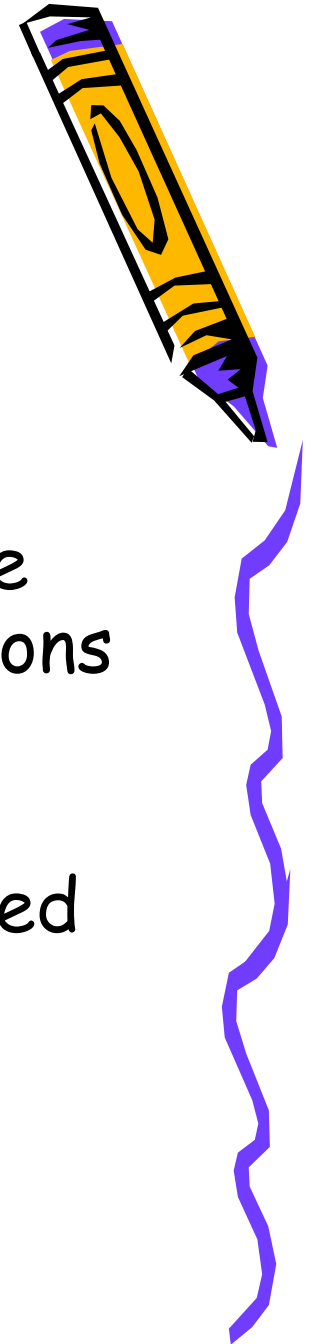
