Summer School will be offered at Lawton High School June 17-July 26, with the week of July 1-5 off for the holiday. The program will be held at the High School from 8:00 AM-11:30 AM, Monday-Friday. All course work will be done online using Apex Online Learning and is focused on credit recovery only. There will be no virtual option.

To register, please bring completed form and payment to the High School Guidance Office. The office will be open June 10-14 from 8am to noon, as well as the first day of summer school on June 17th. The cost per class is as follows:

\$45.00 per class

\$20.00 per class for free/reduced lunch students

All costs must be paid in full prior to the first day of class.

Checks may be made payable to Lawton Community Schools.

Guidelines for summer school are as follows:

- The student must attend **every day and be on time.**
- If the student has a behavior problem and is asked to leave, they will not be readmitted to summer school for the session they are currently taking and **will not be issued a refund.**
- Once a student completes their class(es) they are no longer required to attend.

We would also like to make you aware that a failed class results in the student athlete not being able to participate in any Fall sport for 10% of the season. If a student makes up a credit in summer school before the start of the next season, they will not have to sit out of any contests. Two failed classes will result in the student athlete being ineligible for the entire Fall season.

Because your student has elected to take 4 years of LHS Band, as well as enrolling in a program at VB Tech, they will need to take some additional courses (beyond the traditional school day) in order to meet the Michigan Merit Curriculum graduation requirements. We will allow them to do this either during the 2024-2025 school, or they may take these courses during summer school. Either way, it will be provided at no cost to your family.

If you choose summer school, bring completed form and payment to the High School Guidance Office. The office will be open June 10-14 from 8am to noon, as well as the first day of summer school on June 17th.
